### NGAOK Scholarship Application Academic Year Spring, Summer & Fall 2020

Dear Applicant:

Thank you for your interest in applying for a scholarship sponsored by the *National Guard Association of Oklahoma Scholarship Foundation*, the *National Guard Association of Oklahoma*, and members and corporate sponsors. It is indeed a privilege and pleasure to recognize your commitment to furthering your education and your interest in this year's scholarship. To ensure you are a viable candidate for a scholarship, follow the application guidelines below.

**Applications that are incorrectly filled out or incomplete will be dropped from the selection process.**

#### **Application Guidelines & Eligibility – PLEASE READ AND FOLLOW CAREFULLY**

1. The application must be completely filled out. If a section does not apply to you or your situation, simply type N/A in the appropriate block. If you have supporting documentation to add to the application, please fill out the spaces provided, then add "See Attached" and included the documents with your submission.
2. You or your sponsor -- if you are a family member -- must be a member of the National Guard Association of Oklahoma (NGAOK). A member of the Oklahoma National Guard is not necessarily a member of the NGAOK. **Proof of membership must be included with the application.** Status may be verified by contacting your unit NGAOK representative or by emailing [ngaokdirector@coxinet.net](mailto:ngaokdirector@coxinet.net).
3. A family member is defined as a child or spouse of an NGAOK member. The spouse must be legally married to the NGAOK member. A child must be of dependent age (younger than 25 years of age and not married) and must be legally adopted, a biological child, or a step-child of an NGAOK member by submission deadline. Beginning in 2014, the NGAOK Scholarship Foundation began offering scholarships to primary next-of-kin and surviving children of OKNG members who died from injuries sustained in combat on or after September 11, 2001. Primary next-of-kin of our Fallen Heroes are considered life members of the NGAOK.
4. Official high school and college transcripts must be included. Acceptable proof of ACT/SAT scores includes official transcripts, official letters on school letterhead or other official score results.
5. All applications must be word processed or typed. Handwritten submissions will NOT be accepted.
6. Applications must be emailed to [ngaok.scholarship@gmail.com](mailto:ngaok.scholarship@gmail.com) by the deadline noted on the application. **There will be no exceptions.** All applications must be signed. The signature can be either handwritten or digitally signed. **Ensuring the signature remains on the document is your responsibility as the applicant.**
7. Scholarship awardees must be enrolled in a post-secondary school or training program, either public or private, to **RECEIVE** any scholarship award. Any Scholarship awardees who do not send their schedule to claim their scholarship prior to 1 October 2020, will be forfeited.

**NOTE: There will be no courtesy calls/texts this year for missing paperwork or handwritten apps. Please follow the directions carefully. Adhering carefully to these guidelines will ensure your application is considered for selection. We wish you good luck during this selection process and success in your future educational pursuits.**
