It is indeed a privilege and pleasure to recognize your commitment to furthering your education and your interest in this year's scholarship. To ensure you are a viable candidate for a scholarship, follow the application guidelines below. **Applications that are incorrectly filled out or incomplete will be dropped from the selection process without notification.** Cut off for packet applications is October 31, 2025 with selection notification around November 15.

Application Guidelines & Eligibility – PLEASE READ AND FOLLOW CAREFULLY

1. The application must be filled out completely. If a section does not apply to you or your situation, simply type N/A in the appropriate block. If you have supporting documentation to add to the application, please fill out the spaces provided, then add "See Attached" and included the documents with your submission.
2. You or your sponsor -- if you are a family member -- must be a member of the National Guard Association of Oklahoma (NGAOK). A member of the Oklahoma National Guard is not necessarily a member of the NGAOK. **Proof of membership must be included with the application.** Status may be verified by contacting your MSC/Wing NGAOK representative at ngaok@coxinet.net.
3. A family member is defined as a child or spouse of an NGAOK member. The spouse must be legally married to the NGAOK member. A child must be of dependent age (17-21 years of age and not married) and must be legally adopted, a biological child, or a stepchild of an NGAOK member by submission deadline.
4. Copies of college/vocational transcripts and current enrollment schedules, if freshman year then current schedule is all that is needed along with letter. Letter to the board explaining major fields of study or training and why you are choosing this career path.
5. All applications must be word processed or typed. Handwritten submissions will NOT be accepted.
6. Completed packets must be consolidated into one digital file and emailed to NGAOK.scholarships@gmail.com October 31, 2025. All applications must be signed. The signature can be either handwritten or digitally signed.
7. Scholarship awardees must be enrolled in a post-secondary school or training program, either public or private, to **RECEIVE** any scholarship award.
8. Typed Essay of no less than 300 words and no more than 350 words to be included with application. This year's theme is explaining the history of the Oklahoma National Guard in your words. **AI generated essays will be disqualified.**

Adhering carefully to these guidelines will ensure your application is considered for selection. We wish you good luck during this selection process and success in your future educational pursuits.
